The Commemorative Partner Program is designed for federal, state and local communities, veterans' organizations and other nongovernmental organizations to assist a grateful nation in thanking and honoring U.S. Vietnam Veterans and their families. Commemorative Partners participate in the Commemoration of the Vietnam War by organizing ceremonies that recognize Vietnam Veterans and their families' service, valor, and sacrifice. Their events and activities are dignified, memorable occasions that show a sensitivity and appreciation for the solemnity

of war and the losses suffered by many. Commemorative Partners strive to achieve the five major objectives of the Congressionally-mandated program. The principal objective is to thank and honor veterans of the Vietnam War for their service and sacrifice on behalf of the United States ... and to thank and honor the families of these veterans.

The EC-47 History Site chronicles the venerable "Electric Goon" and the service, sacrifice and valor of those who crewed and maintained the nearly 70 electronic reconnaissance aircraft during the Vietnam War. Established by EC-47 flight engineer J.C. Wheeler in 1997, the website was updated in 2014 and registered as a Commemoration Partner in June 2015. Nearly fifteen like-minded organizations make up this Commemorative Partner Program committee.
