Please familiarize yourself with the following rules before registering your bid to ensure the auction runs smoothly and we all have a great time.

- 1. Bidding begins on Tuesday, March 28th at 4:00 PM.
- 2. Bidding ends on Wednesday, March 29th at 7:00 PM.
- 3. The auction item value listed is based on its fair market value, as determined by the item's retail cost and the **EC-47 History Site managers**.
- 4. All bids must meet the minimum bid requirements, or they will be disqualified.
- 5. Bidders may bid multiple times on the same item as long as they meet the bid minimum.
- 6. All bids are FINAL.
- 7. Bidders agree to pay in full the amount by cash or check at the conclusion of the auction. Credit card payment may also be arranged using the EC-47 History Site PayPal Service.
- 8. The Heritage Chapter-FTVA and The EC-47 History Site assume no liability for risk or hazards associated with items won. Winner assumes all responsibility for risk and injury.
- 9. Items are subject to change or be withdrawn without notice at any time.
- 10. The bidder with the highest recorded bid at the close of the auction will win the item.
- 11. Items will not be released to winners until payment has been received in full.
- 12. All items are new and sold as-is. The EC-47 History Site representatives will assist with packing and shipping as requested by the item winners.
